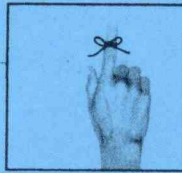

Indemnity Clarification for dog's use at Park

Times have changed and we have been threatened with law suits, sadly, because of dogs in our Park. The Association must protect itself and its insurance coverage. Members who own dogs that use the Park are required to indemnify and release the HPPOC for any liability they and their dog(s) may potentially cause or suffer.

Members who do not bring their dogs to the Park are free to frequent the Park during open Park hours.

As a friendly reminder.....The Good Neighbor Rules were adopted on 5/27/08. We trust those who frequent the Park follow the Rules; which can be downloaded from our website at www.hppoc.org. The Rules are also posted at the Park.

You are responsible for your dog. New indemnity agreements were recently mailed. If you receive a reminder, please kindly fill it out and return it. If you are not sure you signed a new agreement, please call the office.

GRAFFITI and VANDALISM in our neighborhood!!

The Huntington has fallen victim to tagging four times this year!

- The north wall inside of the Corona del Mar Park on the Cal Trans side was spray painted on September 29, the day of the Annual Party in the Park.
- The Cal Trans wall facing the street on Corona del Mar was defaced on December 14, that same morning, a construction fence on CDM was also hit.
- On Christmas Eve the south wall inside the CDM Park was tagged.
- All offences have been repainted
- The event on 12/14 at the Park was captured on tape by a resident; because it was at 4:15 in the morning and still dark, both the perpetrator and his vehicle were unrecognizable in the footage provided by the resident.
- Also a home on Ocampo, near Alma Real was vandalized by kids shooting paint balls in early December.

Please keep close watch on the neighborhood. Call your security service or the police if you see any suspicious activity.
