Corona del Mar Park

In 2009 the Park was used for some wonderful parties & weddings as well as being enjoyed by many families and their dogs. Sadly however, there have been a few issues that the Board has had to address at the Park & the Board wanted to make you aware of them:

- Graffiti was painted on the walls several times in 2009.

- In November 2009 a note was "planted" in the Park stating there was Rat Poison in the Park. The HPPOC Board immediately hired a pest control company to inspect the park and found no evidence of any poison.

- On January 10, 2010, a resident found several packages of unopened mouse poison in the Park at various locations throughout the Park. Everyone who uses the Park needs to be aware of this. Please use caution when using the Park, check your surroundings. If you see any suspicious behavior, please contact the patrol (number is at the park) or the police.
