Halloween Safety Tips:

Halloween is just around the corner & board member Sue Helmy 15 year Huntington resident thought it would be a fun idea to give our residents a few helpful hints and suggestions to take into consideration this Halloween:

1. Halloween this year falls on a Monday, and also falls before Daylight Savings Time ends so we do not adjust our clocks until the following weekend on Saturday, Nov. 5.

This Halloween sunset will be at 6:13 pm, so be prepared for Trick or Treaters to knock on your door anywhere from 5-10! Don't be afraid to turn off your lights, Trick or Treaters know that means you are done for the night.

2. Plan to have an early dinner. At least that way your kids will have an uninterrupted dinner, and will not be trick or treating on an empty stomach.

3. Some blocks on Ocampo Drive get an enormous amount of children visiting each home, be patient and enjoy the fun! Every kid (young and old) loves to be told how cute they are.

4. Use sensible safety precautions: Cross streets using the crosswalks, trick or treat in a group, carry a bottle of water, a cell phone, and a flash light. Do not let your child's mask obstruct their peripheral vision. Wear light or bright colors so that they can be seen in the dark. Do not go into cars of strangers.

5. Get a general idea of where you will be going. Some of the streets in this area are windy, and may take longer than you are expecting.

The Huntington Homeowners Association cares about our children and has arranged an additional ADT patrol car to help keep our neighborhood safe.



Pampas Ricas Trees

Leaf Blowers in our neighborhood:

Gas powered leaf blowers are not only a noisy nuisance but they also cause unnecessary gas pollution and they are illegal. The ordinance states ***"No gas powered blower shall be used within 500 feet of a residence at anytime. Both user of such a blower as well as the individual who contracted for the services of the user if any, shall be subject to the requirements of and penalty provisions fore this ordinance. Violation of the provisions of this subsection shall be punishable as an infraction in an amount not to exceed \$100."*** This section does not preclude anyone from using other devices such as a gas powered vacuum device or an electric leaf blower. If your gardener uses a gas blower, please ask him to purchase an electric one to avoid costly fines and to be in compliance with ordinance 112.04(c) LAMC.
